Module 1. International Trade Policies: An Asian Perspective

This module introduces essential concepts of international trade, principles of international trade, and current international trade policies in Asian countries focusing on China, East Asian, and ASEAN countries. The module covers current international trade policies of countries in the Asian region and assesses its compliance with regulations of international economic institutions. Analysis of and lessons from trade policy reform from Asian countries are significant part of the module. After the module, participants are able to understand and analyze trade policies as well as their effects on economic development of the countries in the region.



• Module 2. Trade and Development This module provides participants with basic tools to analyse how international trade affects various aspects of economic development including economic growth, changes in economic structure, social issues, and environmental issues. Case studies of Asian countries as mentioned above are heavily used to illustrate reality linked with theories. Participants are expected to grasp techniques used to analyse possible links between international trade and issues of economic development



TRAVEL PLANNING:

• Visa Application will be supported by Department of International Affairs of Foreign Trade University

• Student will be picked up at the airport on a designated time (2 trips per day) by FTU buddies upon flight information provided to FTU and transferred to the airport on the day of departure.

Module 3. International Trade Negotiation

The module aims to equip participants with **knowledge about the negotiation process**, which includes influence of human interests, goals, perceptions, and emotions. The module provides participants with concepts and tools to develop skills in diagnosing and managing negotiations in international trade including inter-governmental negotiations.

The module is designed in a group work case and moot negotiation, with simulation exercises, guided through series of tutorials. Participants also have a chance to listen to trade negotiators from government officials, experts, and business persons.



TEACHING METHOD:

Teaching consists of **lectures**, **case studies**, **group work**, **simulation**, and **visits to organizations and businesses** (if demanded).

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES:

Beside the courses, students will have opportunities to engage in **cultural activities** such as sightseeings, outdoor activities.
